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

Located in a leafy residential area in Thorne, Doncaster, Harry Priestley House provides residential care and support for up to 12 adults with learning disabilities. The warm, inviting family environment makes you feel at ease instantly.

We want you to feel right at home with us. Here at Harry Priestley House, you will have a spacious, fully furnished bedroom and a specialist team to support your care needs.

The Home's bedrooms are of varying sizes and on the ground floor there are large lounges for you to relax and socialise. There is also a dining room, kitchen, utility room and a picturesque garden, where you can spend time to enjoy the outdoors.

In addition, we offer a variety of support services for residents to engage in the local community and to take part in activities outside the Home.





What we offer

Moving into a care home doesn't mean you have to give up your independence. We're here to help you to live the life you want, whilst knowing that support is on-hand if you need it.

Fresh homemade food

Our friendly staff team prepare fresh meals every day to give you a range of options and a balanced diet. If you like to, you can join in the cooking and also accompany staff to the local shops to purchase foods you would like to eat.

There's something for everyone

We believe that keeping active both mentally and physically allows our residents to experience wellbeing and meaningfulness.

We support residents with regular activities at Harry Priestley House so you can continue to enjoy your own hobbies and interests and take part in activities with other residents.

Some of the hobbies our residents enjoy include arts and crafts, music and singing, or solving jigsaws.

If you wish to, you can also join the local community by volunteering in a charity shop.

Harry Priestley House is operated and managed by The Royal Masonic Benevolent Institution Care Company (RMBI Care Co). It is also regulated by the Care Quality Commission.

Caring is our way of life. As an organisation, our values are: Kind, Supportive and Trusted. We aim to live by these values, and this is shown throughout our work and how we treat others.

We are Kind: We are kind to our residents, their families and each other because we are passionate about how we deliver care. We believe that everyone should be treated with dignity and their wishes respected at all times.

We are **Supportive**: We are here to help and be supportive in our approach to care, placing residents at the heart of all we do. We treat each person as an individual, recognising the things that are important to them and working as a team to achieve this.

We are **Trusted**: We are open, honest and trusted in delivering care to Freemasons, their dependants and the wider communities. We have been supporting older people for over 170 years, and we work closely with our residents, their families and each other to offer a safe environment.



Types of care & support

Making the decision to move into a care home can be difficult - that's why we're here to support you every step of the way.

Residential care

At Harry Priestley House, we provide residential care for people with learning disabilities who can no longer live at home and need support throughout the day. It can help people to live safely, whilst giving family members peace of mind, knowing that you are in a supportive environment.

We can support you with everyday tasks, from personal care to support in the community. We will help you with medical appointments, financial support or any other tasks of daily life that you may find difficult to do.

We also support people during the early stages of dementia, offer end-of-life support and care for residents with complex needs, such as autism.

Mobility Support

The Home is well-equipped to support people who are less mobile to ensure you can continue to live as independently as possible.

We have two vehicles to support residents on trips outside the Home, for instance to attend local Day Centres. One of our vans is adapted to transport wheelchairs.

To help with mobility, we also have a tracking hoist and an assisted bath on the ground floor, as well as a fitted stair lift to help you access the first floor.

Additional Services

We work closely with external specialists to offer our residents additional care and services, including physiotherapy and occupational therapy. A chiropodist and our mobile hairdresser visit the Home regularly, to offer these
